- Most job applications are to be completed online.
- All companies do not list a phone number, so you need to make electronic contacts.
- Some companies are foreign-based and some are local subcontractors. Local subcontractors may have a partnership agreement with foreign companies in “joint ventures.”
- Job opportunities in the oil industry can be for Guyanese who are skilled, semi-skilled or limited in skills. Those who are semi-skilled and unskilled may benefit from additional training or on-the-job training provided by employers.
- Jobs in the oil industry can be:
 - Direct employment:** You work directly for Exxon, CNOOC or Hess, or their subsidiaries engaged in various aspects of upstream, midstream, or downstream oil operations.
 - Indirect employment:** You work for a subcontractor of a subcontractor involved in a particular aspect within the supply chain of goods and services.
 - Induced employment:** You get work with an entity because all the new spending on oil related projects have created the need for new or more jobs in the economy.
- In the Directory, in the left column, it is indicated whether the main focus of the company is **jobs**, **training**, or a combination of **jobs/training**.
