OGGN Formation and Mission

Created in the summer of 2017 in NYC

- We are a 501(c)(3) Public Charity, see <u>www.oggn.org/about</u>
- Our members are professors, teachers, engineers, oil experts, accountants, etc
- We have written over 300 articles in the Guyanese newspapers related to Guyana's Oil

Our mission is to renegotiate the Stabroek Oil Contract for a fair deal

- Guyana discovered oil in 2015 and started production in December 2019
- Today estimated reserves stand at 18.7 billion barrels or at US\$80/barrel about US\$1.5 trillion
 - That is 750 times the pre-oil government budget of US\$2 billion
- More than 40% of the 780,000 Guyanese live in Guyana on US\$5.50 a day
- We only receive 14.5 barrels out of every 100 whereas we consider a fair allocation 55 barrels
- We are NOT political, we have pressured both the current and previous administration for a better contract

Unfair Distribution of Oil Profits for 2023

US\$7.8 billion total Oil Company Profits

- Guyana received US\$1.4 billion from those profits from a 50/50 profits share agreement
- But Guyana may have wrote FAKE tax receipts for the oil companies totaling US\$1.5 billion

We are not covered for a major oil spill

We pump 640,000 barrels a day

The projects pump above the recommended safety limits

- The Macondo Oil Spill in Gulf of Mexico estimated to cost US\$145 billion
- The EPA permits requires Exxon to provide Unlimited Parent Company Guarantee
 - A major oil spill can bankrupt the Caribbean WITHOUT this Guarantee
